EVENING Emergency Warming Shelters - Services provided from 7 p.m. - 8 a.m. each night.

Need Transportation to Get to a Warming Center?

Empire Transit will provide free bus transportation to the warming centers now through 8 a.m. Thursday, November 10. Please let the bus driver know you need to go to one of the warming shelters and you can ride for free. This free ride only is for transportation to a warming center in Clatsop County.

If you are elderly or have a disability, you may request the Curb to Curb service (right to the shelter location), however, that can take a day to set up. For Curb to Curb, they will need to call the RideAssist reservation line at 503-861-7433 (Option #2). The reservation line is open Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

If the Power Goes Out

- Do not attempt to touch or move downed powerlines.
- Stay away from any lines that are down or tangled as they may still be energized (carrying electricity).
