Temps May Drop Below Freezing

- Sunday, January 29 - Thursday, February 2, a low-pressure system will bring colder temps. Lows likely will **drop below freezing (32 degrees) on Sunday and Monday mornings.**

Be Prepared

- Assemble or restock your emergency kit. Include these items:
 - First-aid kit
 - Warm blankets
 - Flashlights
 - Batteries
 - Matches
 - Nonperishable food
 - Water
 - Battery operated radio
- Update your contact info with your utility so they can reach you
- Sign up to get text, email or phone alerts from your utility during an outage

Emergency Warming Centers

Due to freezing temperatures, beginning Thursday, January 26 to Wednesday, February 1:

- The Seaside Warming Center will open earlier at 4 p.m. and will close the following morning at 8:30 a.m.
- The Seaside Helping Hands Drop-In Center will open during the day until 4 p.m. The Seaside Warming Center is located at 1530 S. Roosevelt Drive.

- The Astoria Warming Center will expand services to 24 hours a day from Sunday, January 29 through 8 a.m. Wednesday, February 1.

LiFEBoat services will be closed during this cold weather event due to planned repairs.

- **SEASIDE** 1530 S. Roosevelt Drive. Case managers will be on site from 7-9 p.m. each night to refer people to services.

- Use [TripCheck](#) to make sure roads are clear
- Do not attempt to touch or move downed powerlines.
- Stay away from any lines that are down or tangled as they may still be energized (carrying electricity).
